Step 1: Once the link is opened, you have 2 options, an option to complete a waiver for yourself, and an option to complete one for yourself and children. Click the option applicable to you. Please note, each adult must sign their own waiver.

Any litigation involving the parties to this Release Agreement shall be brought solely within Ontario, and shall be within the exclusive jurisdiction of the Courts of Ontario; and

SEVERABILITY - If any provision of this Agreement is determined by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, illegal or unenforceable in any respect, such determination shall not impair or affect the validity, legality or enforceability of the remaining provisions hereof, and each provision is hereby declared to be separate, severable and distinct.

1. Why won't it let me sign a waiver for my spouse?

a. Our system will not allow an adult to sign a waiver for another adult. A waiver is a legal document and each participant over the age of 18 must read and sign for themselves. Any participant under the age of 18 must have a guardian sign for them.

2. Why can't I use the same email as my spouse?

a. In order to send each copy of your signed waiver you need to use your own email address.

3. I forgot to add a minor can I go back and add one?

a. Yes you can, you can open the waiver link, and start to fill out your email, it will prompt to return to your previous submission and ask if that is you, click yes, and then add a minor with the add minor button, located below contact / personal information

4. I am planning a group outing for my friends and I, do all of us need to sign a waiver, or is it just myself who purchased our tickets?

a. Each participant over the age of 18 must sign and complete their own waiver.

5. Can I send the same link to everyone?

a. Yes, the link is a form that auto populates each time the link is opened, there is no individualized link to your own purchase. The waiver can also be found on the homepage of our website.

6. Does it matter what name I use to sign my waiver?

a. Yes it does, whatever name you sign your waiver with, should match the name of participant for the tickets purchased and their government/ legal issued identification (ex. drivers license).

7. Can I just have my tickets and participate without a waiver?

a. No, you must have a signed and completed waiver before your tickets will be given, and or before you can go and participate.
